Notice to Swansea Mews tenants

Toronto Community Housing has **important news for all Swansea Mews tenants** about steps we are taking to ensure the safety of the community.

Your safety is our top priority. Engineers will need to do additional testing to determine the full extent of the problem, which is believed to date back to the time of Swansea Mews' construction.

To do this testing, you will need to vacate your unit for about two weeks. You'll be provided with temporary lodging at the Humber Lakeshore Campus or in nearby hotels. TCHC will cover the cost of all your transportation and accommodations, providing meals or a per diem for you to purchase food. Tenants began moving to temporary accommodation earlier this week, with approximately 10 families being accommodated. Tenants will continue moving over the weekend to temporary lodgings at Humber Lakeshore and nearby hotels.

While you are away, TCHC will complete additional testing and install structural supports in your unit to protect against the unlikely potential of another incident. As soon as supports are installed, you will be able to return.

TCHC will hold a townhall meeting for Swansea Mews tenants. More details will be provided as soon as timing is confirmed.
